

6100 Alarm Kits

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q:** I know you are discontinuing the 5100 Alarm Kits, but do you still have inventory available for any of these parts?
A: We currently have limited stock on most of the 5100 Alarm Kits and accessories. We will continue to sell off existing inventory and once our stock is gone these products will no longer be available.
- Q:** Are the 5100 Alarm Kits and accessories compatible with the new 6100 Alarm Kits and Accessories?
A: Wireless accessories from the new 6100 **will not work** with 5100 products. However, wired accessories used with the 5100 today, **will work** with the 6100 (just wire to the panel). In regards to alarm communication, the 6100 works exactly the same as the 5100, and both are compatible with the 3015, 7003, and 7705ii receivers. Additionally, if using AES wireless communication, both 5100's and 6100's can be used in the same network.
- Q:** Are the 6100 Alarm Kits on the GSA Schedule?
A: We are currently working on getting all the 6100 Alarm Kits and Accessories added to the GSA Schedule.
- Q:** How does the 6100 Alarm Kits differ from the 5100 Alarm Kits?
A: The main difference between the 5100 Alarm Kits and the 6100 Alarm Kits and accessories is that the 5100 Alarm Kits have to be hard wired to the Alarm Panel and the 6100 Alarm Kits and accessories have all wireless sensors and accessories.
- Q:** How is the 6100 Alarm Kits considered a wireless solution when it has a wired keypad?
A: The 6100 is a considered a wireless solution because all of the sensors/accessories are wireless meaning they do not need to be hard wired to the alarm panel.
- Q:** Is the 6100 Alarm Panel compatible with the 7058-PKG?
A: Yes. The 6100 Alarm Panel is compatible with all 7058 subscribers including the 7058-PKG.
